



WOMEN'S WORLDS CONGRESS 2022

The 14th Women's Worlds Congress is an international and interdisciplinary event, which will take place from 19 to 23 September 2022, at the Main Campus of Universidade Eduardo Mondlane, in Maputo. The meeting's motto is "African FeminismS – building alternatives for women and for the world through a corridor of knowledge that cares and resists".

It starts with the recognition of voices, cosmovisions, arts, practices and rationalities that think and express the world from the African continent viewpoint. To highlight African Feminisms, this call is plural and comprehensive and is open to proposals for reflection from the academy and feminist activism, which question colonialism, capitalism, racism and patriarchy, to resist and build alternatives that will not leave anyone behind.

As Ezra Nhampoca, from the MM2022 Scientific Committee, points out, "you can't be a feminist by half because feminism is the thought that defends equal rights between people".

The Mundos de Mulheres takes place every three years, since 1981, and brings together activists, intellectuals and artists to promote critical and plural thinking, debate and reinterpret the world, its challenges, and think about alternatives to be built, based on diverse feminist experiences and knowledge.

The 14th edition of MM2022 will feature Round Tables, Workshops, Conversations, Debates, Workshops, Exhibitions, Posters, Performances, Installations and Book and Gastronomy Fairs, among others. The official languages are Portuguese, Spanish, English and French.

It is hoped to hold a Congress that will be a transforming landmark for feminisms and for the world. According to Isabel Casimiro, general coordinator of the event, "it is a challenging and very important mission for the academies and for the entire Mozambican society".

To this end, several questions are raised, such as: Does the study of the South remain an exotic Western fetish? To what extent is colonial domination maintained at the level of science and academia? Is Western academic production listening and attributing the same value, epistemological relevance to African knowledge as that produced in the global North? What is the role and place of African Women in Western and African academies? These questions are intended to be answered during the future event.
